We cooperate with other UN-related NGOs, in particular the United Nations Association, and our primary role is to monitor and enhance the United Kingdom's contribution to the renewal and reform of the United Nations system. As one of the five permanent Members of the Security Council, with one of the world's richest economies, this country has particular responsibilities for the United Nations.
